Polka is a dance in which there were many jumps, a lot of learning and a lot of laughter.



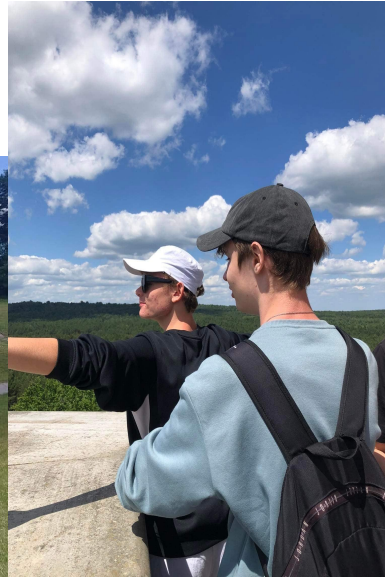

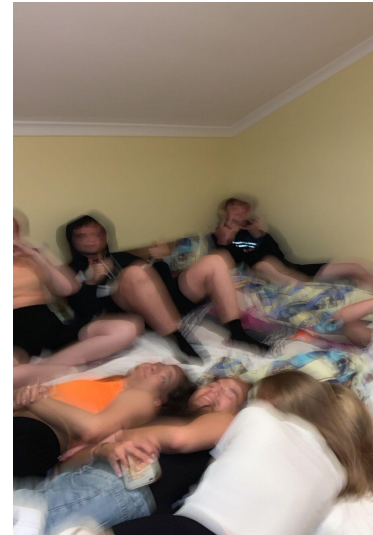
The trip to the Bobolice

Which dance was better?

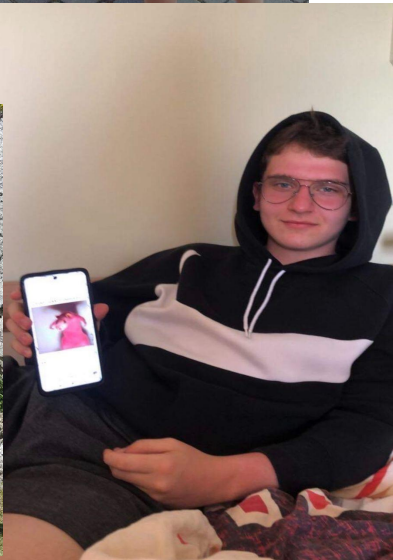
In our opinion the polish dance was a little slower than the Czech one. But we enjoyed it the same as the Polish dance.
